

Spray Packaging Selection Guide

Choose suitable spray packaging by product type, formula texture, spray output, bottle material, capacity, leakage awareness and sales channel.

For Spray Product Projects

Facial mist, toner spray, body spray, deodorant spray, fragrance mist, hair mist, scalp spray, cooling spray and selected gift set spray projects.

Packaging Logic

Why Spray Packaging Needs Early Review

Spray packaging should not be selected only by appearance. Pump structure, bottle material, capacity and sealing details can affect how the product sprays, feels, travels and presents in retail.

Spray Pump Affects Experience

The pump influences mist softness, spray output, coverage area and whether the product feels suitable for face, body, scalp or hair use.

Formula Texture Affects Sprayability

Viscosity, fragrance, humectants, polymers, conditioning agents or oil-phase ingredients can affect pump pass-through and nozzle cleanliness.

Bottle Material Affects Positioning

PET, PP, glass and frosted bottles create different impressions in cost, weight, visual value, shipping practicality and retail positioning.

Sealing Affects Delivery Risk

Cap fit, neck structure, pump assembly and carton protection need review for storage, e-commerce delivery, gift set assembly and export shipping.

Capacity Affects Use Habits

A 30 ml travel mist, 100 ml facial mist and 150 ml body spray are not used, priced or shipped in the same way.

Sales Channel Affects Packaging Route

DTC, Amazon, salon retail, spa, travel kits, holiday sets and professional-use projects may need different packaging choices.

Zerun Review Tip

A spray product should be reviewed with the pump and bottle before final sample confirmation, especially when the formula contains fragrance, humectants, conditioning agents, polymers, botanical extracts or oil-phase ingredients.

Pump Selection

Spray Pump Type Comparison

Different spray products need different pump output, mist softness and coverage. The table below helps compare common spray pump directions before packaging confirmation.

Pump Type	Best For	Key Review	Packaging Note
Fine Mist Pump	Facial mist, toner spray, makeup-friendly mist, soft hydrating spray.	Mist softness, output amount, formula viscosity and facial comfort.	Best with clear, low-viscosity and fine-mist friendly formulas.
Standard Pump Spray	Body spray, deodorant spray, cooling body spray, sports fresh spray.	Coverage area, pump strength, dry-down feel and low-residue formula.	Suitable for body-use products that need wider spray coverage.
Hair / Scalp Spray Pump	Scalp refresh spray, leave-in spray, curl refresh spray, hair mist.	Spray distribution, nozzle direction, residue level and clogging risk.	Choose based on scalp targeting or hair length application.
Mini / Travel Spray Pump	Travel mist, gift set spray, trial size, fragrance mist.	Leakage awareness, cap tightness, spray consistency and label readability.	Good for e-commerce, sample kits, retail trial and holiday sets.
Trigger / Larger Output Spray	Selected large body spray, salon hair spray, back-bar or professional use.	Spray amount, hand feel, bottle size and formula flow.	Not always suitable for facial or premium cosmetic positioning.

Packaging Note

For spray projects, the pump should be tested with the actual formula direction. A pump that works for a water-like facial mist may not work well for a fragrance-rich, milky, bi-phase or light styling spray.

Bottle Materials

Bottle Material Selection

Bottle material affects product appearance, brand positioning, shipping weight and packaging cost. Select the material after reviewing product type, formula appearance, sales channel and pricing plan.

PET / PP Lightweight Bottle

Suitable for body spray, deodorant spray, scalp spray, hair spray and travel body spray. Lightweight, practical and shipping-friendly. Review bottle appearance, pump fit, label effect and market positioning.

Glass / Frosted Glass Bottle

Suitable for premium facial mist, body mist, spa aromatic mist and fragrance-led spray. Offers refined hand feel and stronger visual value. Review weight, breakage risk, shipping cost and outer box protection.

Clear Transparent Bottle

Suitable for clear facial mist, toner spray, body mist and fragrance mist. It shows formula clarity and a clean visual effect. Review whether formula appearance can remain stable and visually clean.

Opaque / Frosted Bottle

Suitable for low-scent skincare mist, premium body spray, haircare spray and selected sensitive-positioned concepts. Review brand identity, label contrast and product price positioning.

Zerun Review Tip

A visually premium bottle should still match formula flow, pump assembly, filling volume, labeling method and shipping route. Packaging appeal and production practicality need to be reviewed together.

Capacity Planning

Capacity And Sales Channel Planning

Spray capacity should match use frequency, sales channel, product role and packaging cost. A travel mist, daily facial mist, body spray and salon-use product should not follow the same capacity logic.

30 ml / 50 ml

Suitable for travel mist, mini fragrance mist, gift set add-on and trial size. Best for e-commerce bundles, subscription boxes, hotel amenities and retail trials. Review small label area, leakage awareness and cap protection.

60 ml / 80 ml / 100 ml

Suitable for facial mist, toner spray, scalp spray, hair mist and travel body spray. Best for DTC skincare, salon retail, travel skincare and daily carry. Review portability, perceived value and use frequency.

120 ml / 150 ml / 200 ml

Suitable for body spray, deodorant spray, cooling body spray, post-shower spray and hair spray. Best for body care retail, gym care, men's care and household daily use. Review pump output, hand feel, shipping weight and carton arrangement.

250 ml+

Suitable for selected salon hair spray, professional body spray, back-bar use or larger daily-use products. Not always suitable for every cosmetic spray. Review packaging, hand feel, shipping cost and sales channel carefully.

Planning Question

Before choosing capacity, clarify where the product will be sold and how often it will be used: travel, daily facial care, body freshness, salon retail, e-commerce bundle, holiday set or professional-use project.

Packaging Checklist

Packaging Risk Checklist

Use this checklist to review common packaging points before confirming spray bottle, pump, label and outer box direction.

Pump Output ☐ Is the mist fine enough or strong enough for the use area? ☐ Does the spray feel suitable for face, body, scalp or hair use? ☐ Does repeated pressing remain stable?	Formula Flow ☐ Can the formula pass through the spray pump smoothly? ☐ Is the formula too viscous, sticky, milky, bi-phase or ingredient-heavy? ☐ Is there any nozzle residue or clogging awareness?
Cap Protection ☐ Is the cap tight enough for storage, delivery and travel use? ☐ Does the pump need extra cap or clip protection? ☐ Is the packaging suitable for e-commerce or gift set handling?	Leakage Awareness ☐ Do the bottle, pump and neck structure need extra sealing review? ☐ Is filling volume suitable for the bottle and pump structure? ☐ Does export packing need additional protection?
Label Area ☐ Is there enough label space for brand name, product name and volume? ☐ Will the label remain readable on mini or curved bottles? ☐ Does the label effect match bottle material and product positioning?	Outer Box / Carton ☐ Does the product need an individual box, gift set tray or export carton? ☐ Is carton packing suitable for bottle weight and pump protection? ☐ Does retail presentation match shipping protection needs?

This checklist does not replace product testing. It helps brands and Zerun identify packaging points that should be reviewed before sample confirmation, bulk filling or shipment.

Next Step

How Zerun Helps Match Spray Packaging

Zerun reviews spray packaging together with formula texture, use area, target market and production route. This helps brands avoid selecting a bottle only by appearance before checking pump and formula compatibility.

01	Review your spray product type and use area	Clarify whether the project is a facial mist, body spray, deodorant spray, fragrance mist, hair mist, scalp spray or selected gift set spray.
02	Match texture and formula flow with spray pump options	Review whether the formula direction is clear water-based, enriched clear, milky light emulsion, bi-phase or selected styling-oriented spray.
03	Compare bottle material, capacity and visual positioning	Review PET, PP, glass, frosted, mini, premium and travel spray options according to sales channel and price positioning.
04	Review sealing, cap protection, label area and outer box needs	Check packaging details that may affect storage, e-commerce delivery, gift set assembly, export carton packing and retail presentation.
05	Confirm packaging route before sample or bulk production	Align formula route, pump output, bottle structure, label method and packing plan before moving toward production confirmation.
